



Arlesey & Henlow Station

Opened 1850 Arlesey & Shefford Road Station

1933 Name was changed to Arlesey & Henlow

Arlesey signal box can be seen, the level crossing gates are closed to road traffic, train approaching from the north (Biggleswade) Pedestrian Bridge spanning the railway, platform & waiting room for north bound passengers on the left.

At this point the rail tracks are reduced from four lines to two.

Under the 'Beeching Plan' Arlesey & Henlow Station was closed for passenger traffic on 5th January 1958 & for goods traffic 28th November 1960.

The level crossing gates continued to be used until the road bridge was opened to traffic October 1969.

The signal box was demolished in 1976 to permit a 'down & up slow line' to be laid.
